

# Cuyahoga Valley National Park Volunteer Program

## Corporate or Organization Project Menu



Volunteering activities provide a great team building experience for your group, while making a positive impact to your national park. We work closely with park and park partner staff to identify rewarding projects that support park needs in these general categories:

**Habitat Restoration:** Volunteers will remove invasive plant species from areas in the park using field equipment, manual tools or other appropriate methods including hand pulling. Volunteers may also be involved in replanting the site with native species. *This could be a customized day/time or with our public drop-in events – schedule can be found on our website at [www.nps.gov/cuva/getinvolved/supportyourpark/habitat-restoration](http://www.nps.gov/cuva/getinvolved/supportyourpark/habitat-restoration) .* (Up to 300 volunteers)

**Landscaping:** Volunteers will assist with projects including creating new vegetable or flower gardens, upkeep of current beds, raking, planting etc. around park facilities. Supply funding would be very helpful for these projects. (Up to 50 volunteers)

**Facility Maintenance:** Volunteers will assist with cleaning and maintenance projects in visitor centers and office facilities. This could include painting (and paint prep), cleaning windows, moving furniture etc. Supply funding would be very helpful for these projects. (Up to 30 volunteers)

**Trail Maintenance:** Volunteers will assist with maintenance and upkeep of trails including removing leaves from ditches, digging culverts, replacing stairs, pruning branches, etc. Supply funding would be very helpful for these projects. (Up to 30 volunteers)

**Railroad Car Maintenance:** Volunteers will assist with maintenance of railroad cars and railroad yard. This could include painting cars or areas in the facility, cleaning cars etc. (Up to 20 volunteers)

**Program Assistance:** Volunteers will help by prepping and cleaning program supplies including bicycles, fish nets, and winter sports equipment. (Up to 20 volunteers)
